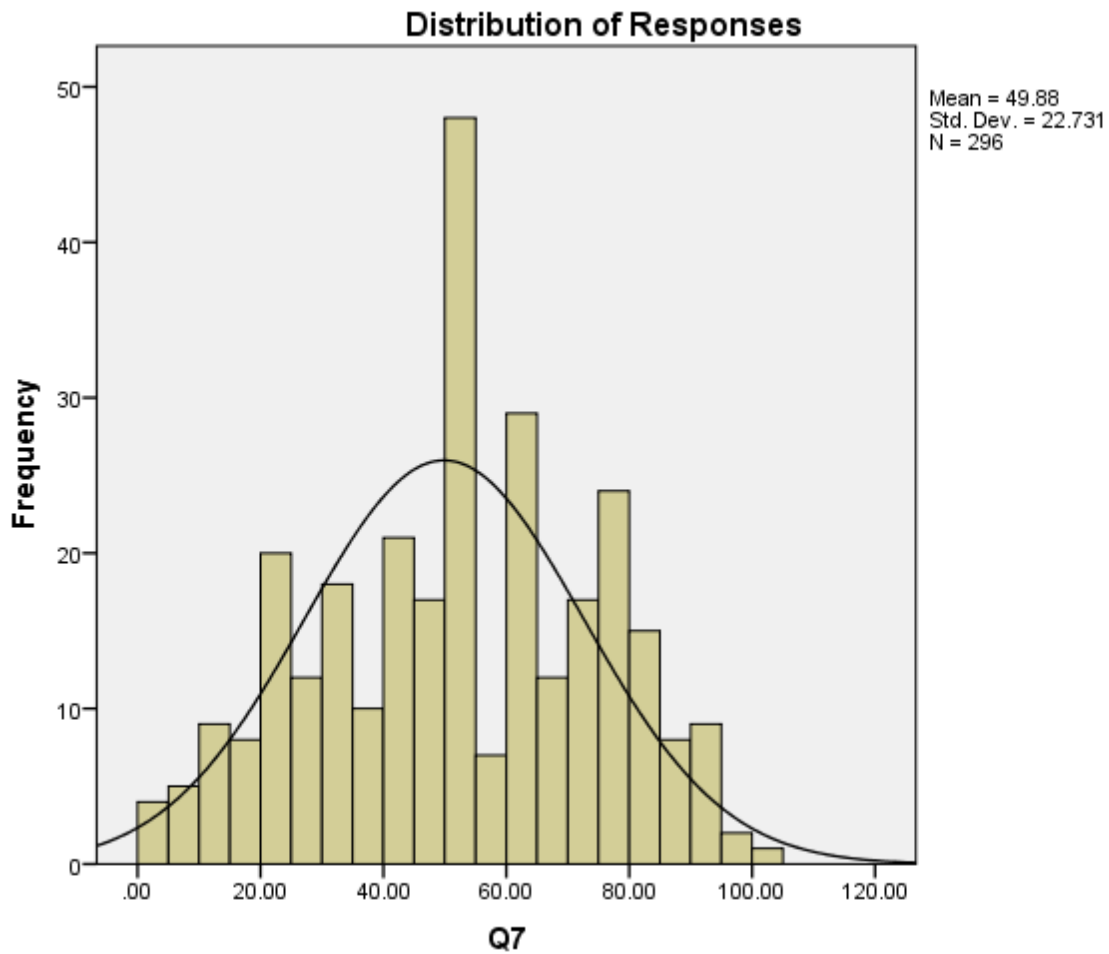

Responses ranged from 1% to 100%, with both median and modal responses being 50%.

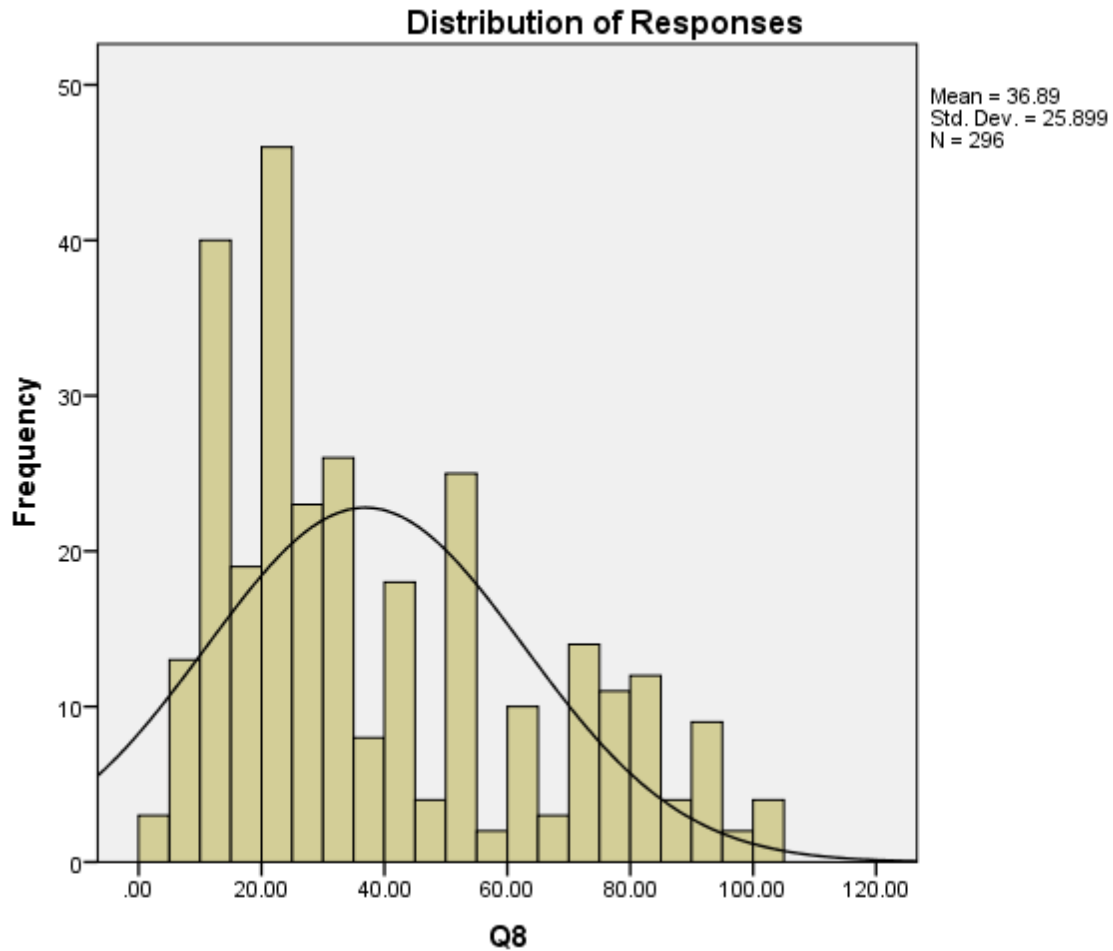

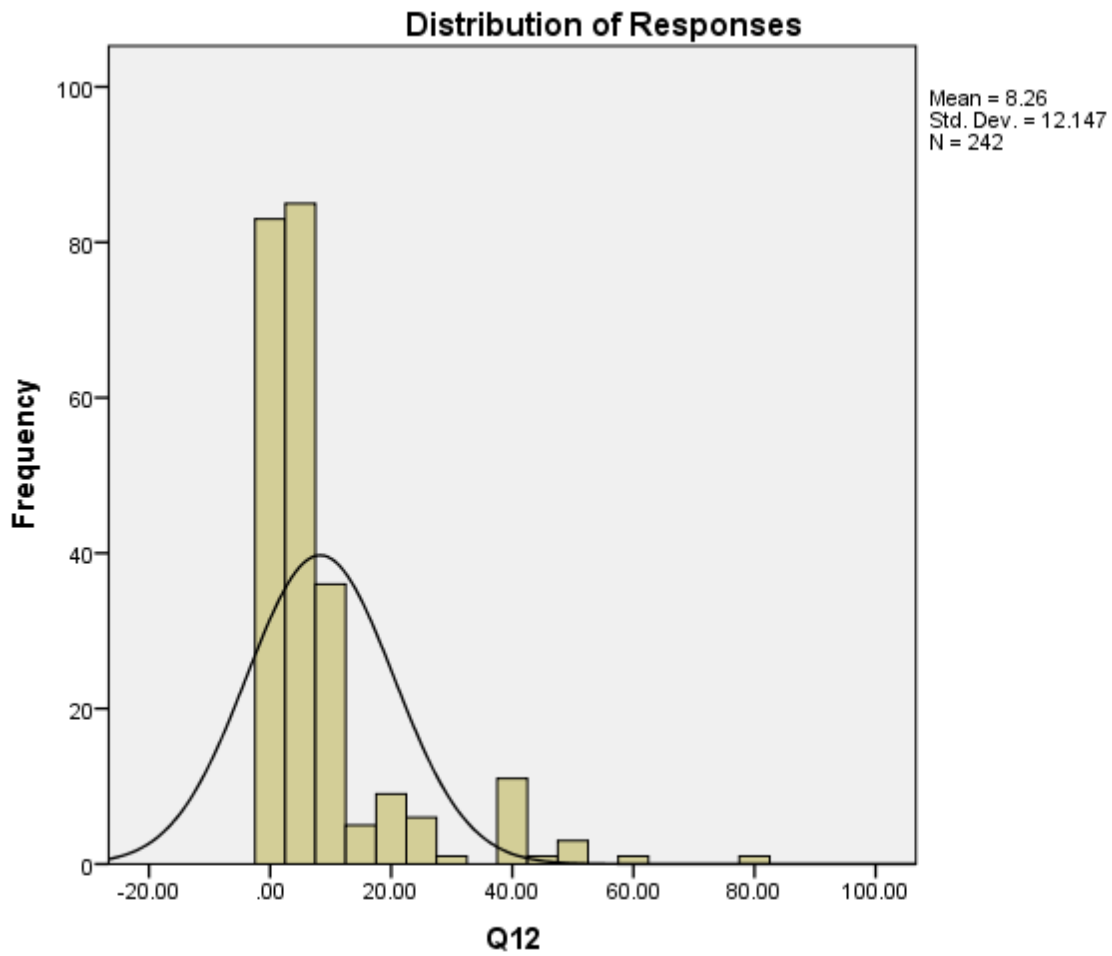

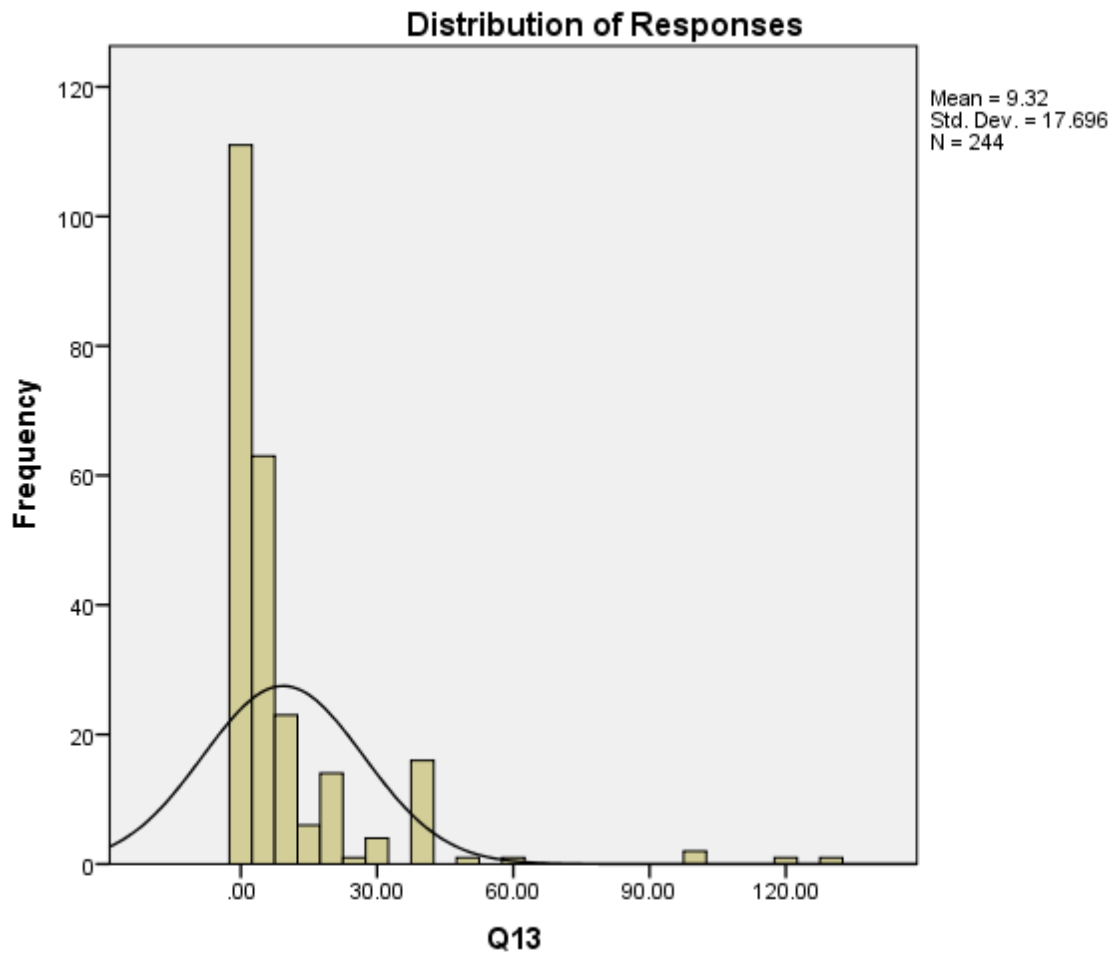
