



For the Likert Scale Question, Higher Means are More Positive than Lower Means







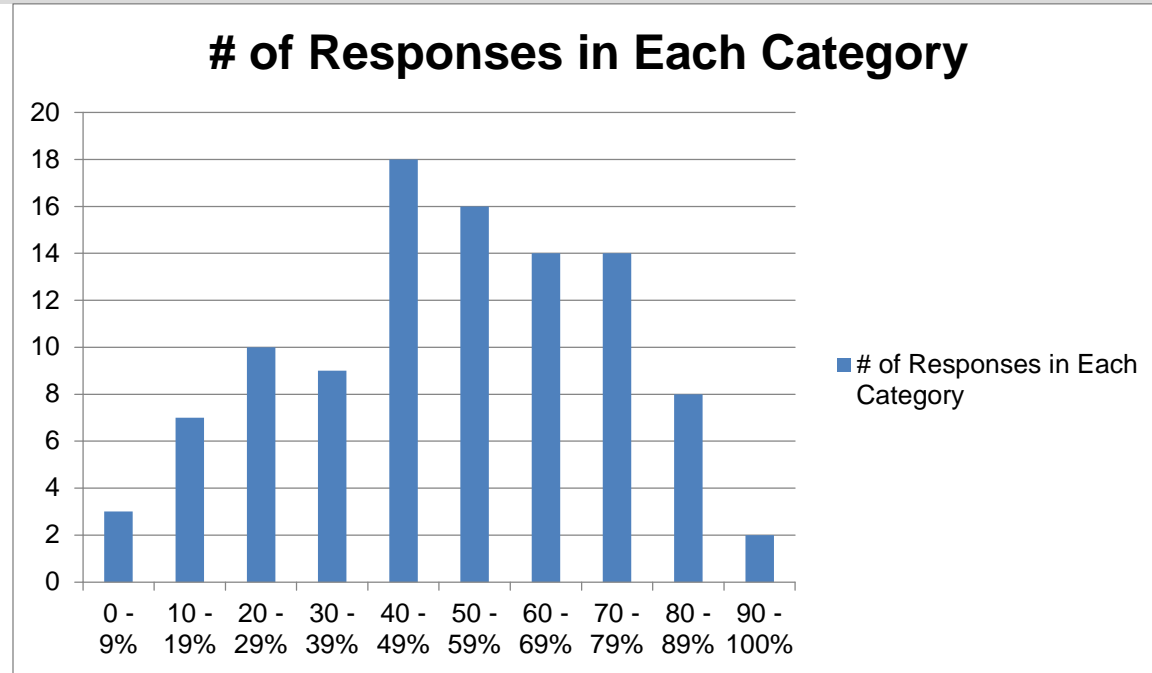

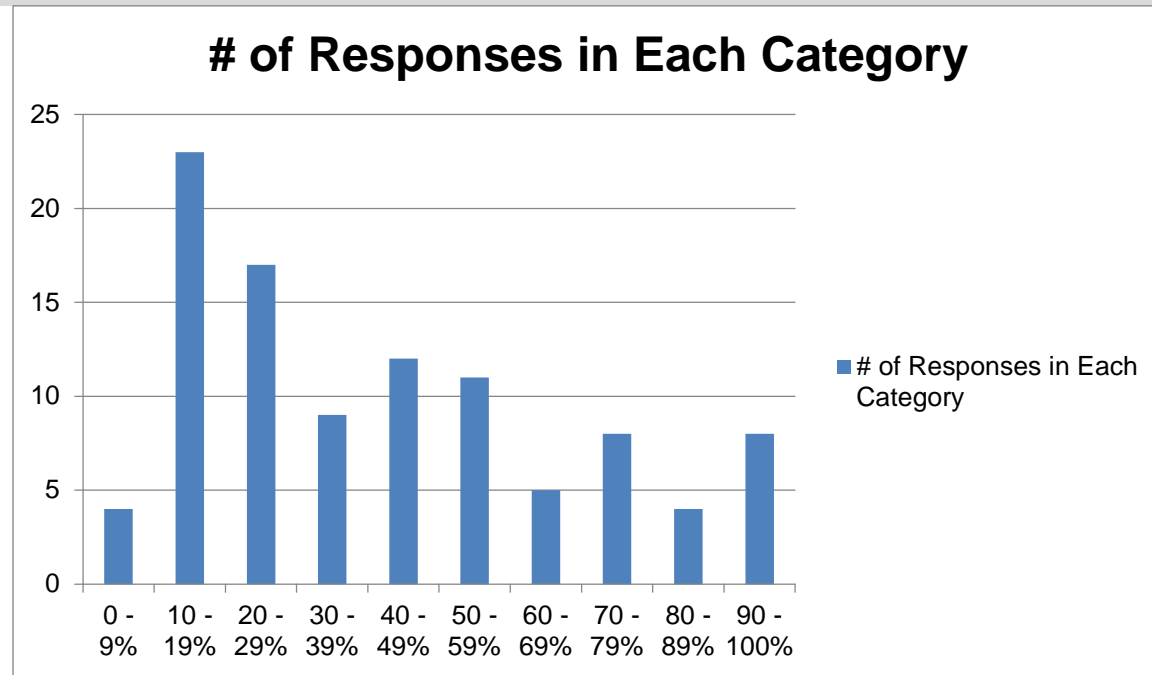

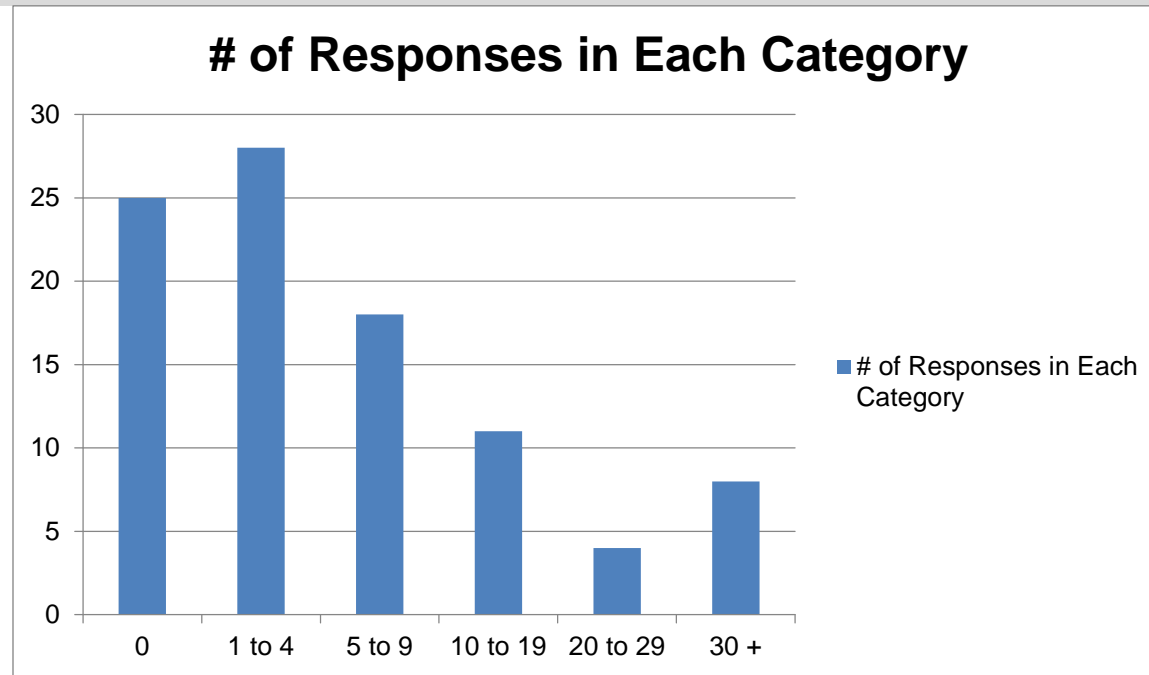

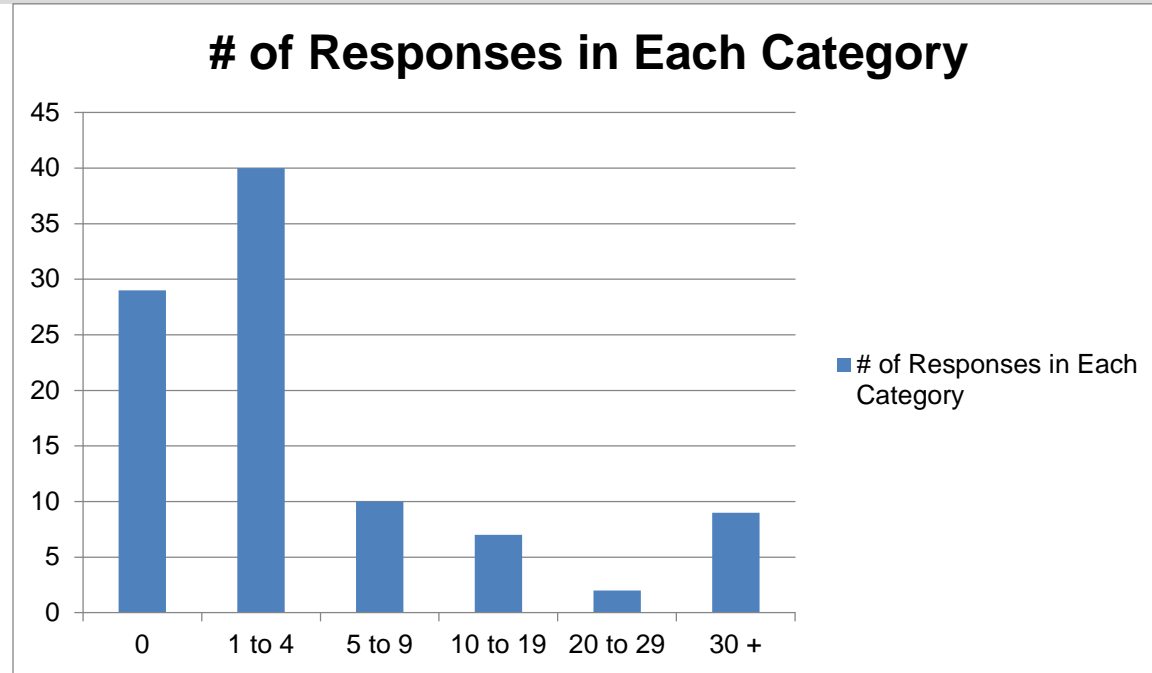
