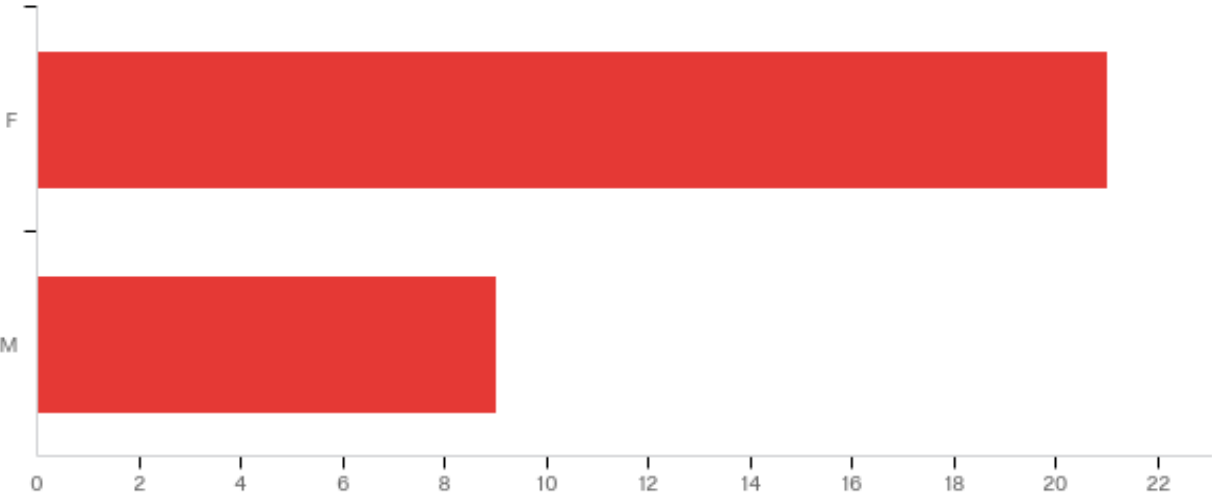

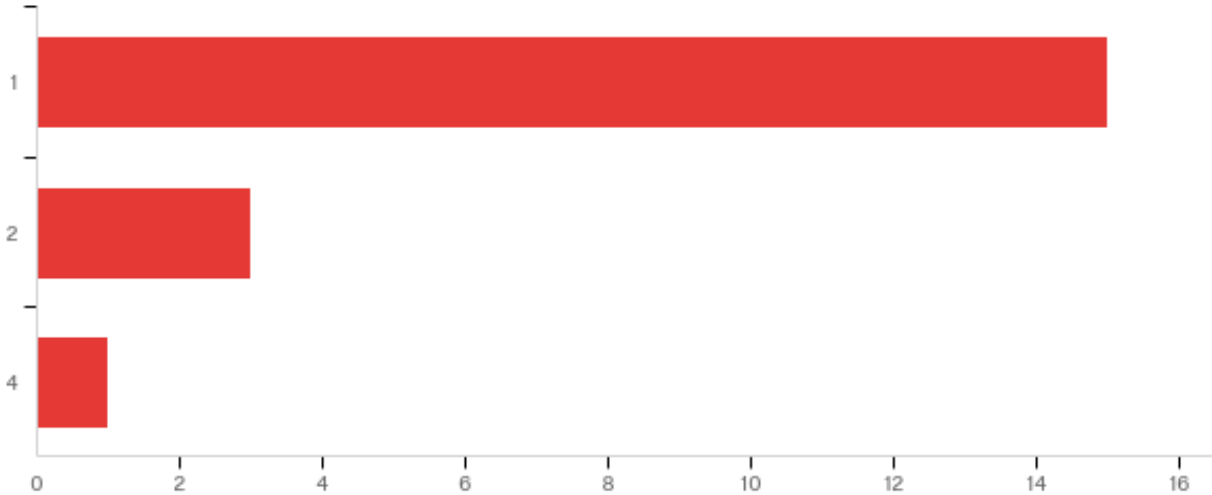

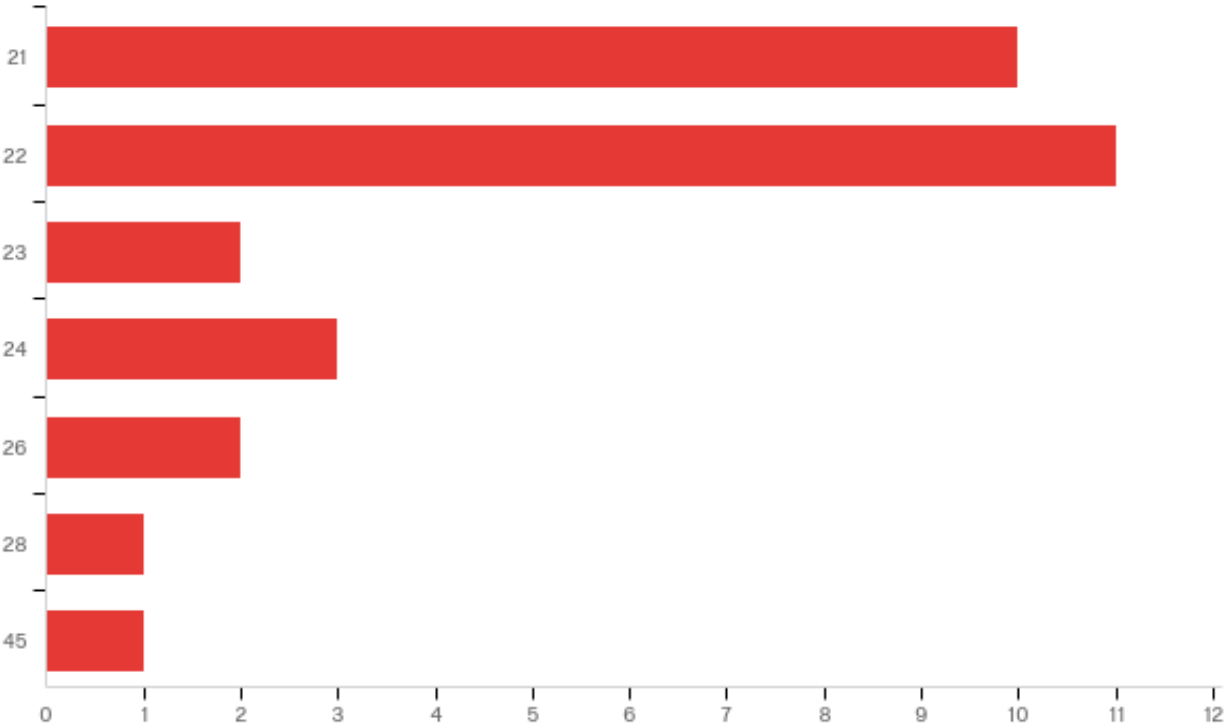

Race



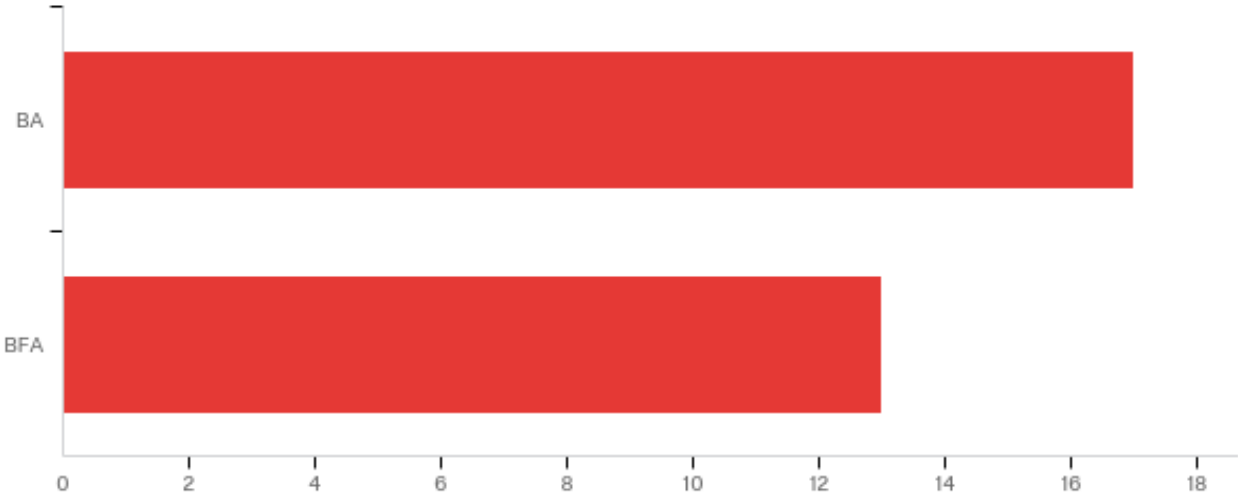

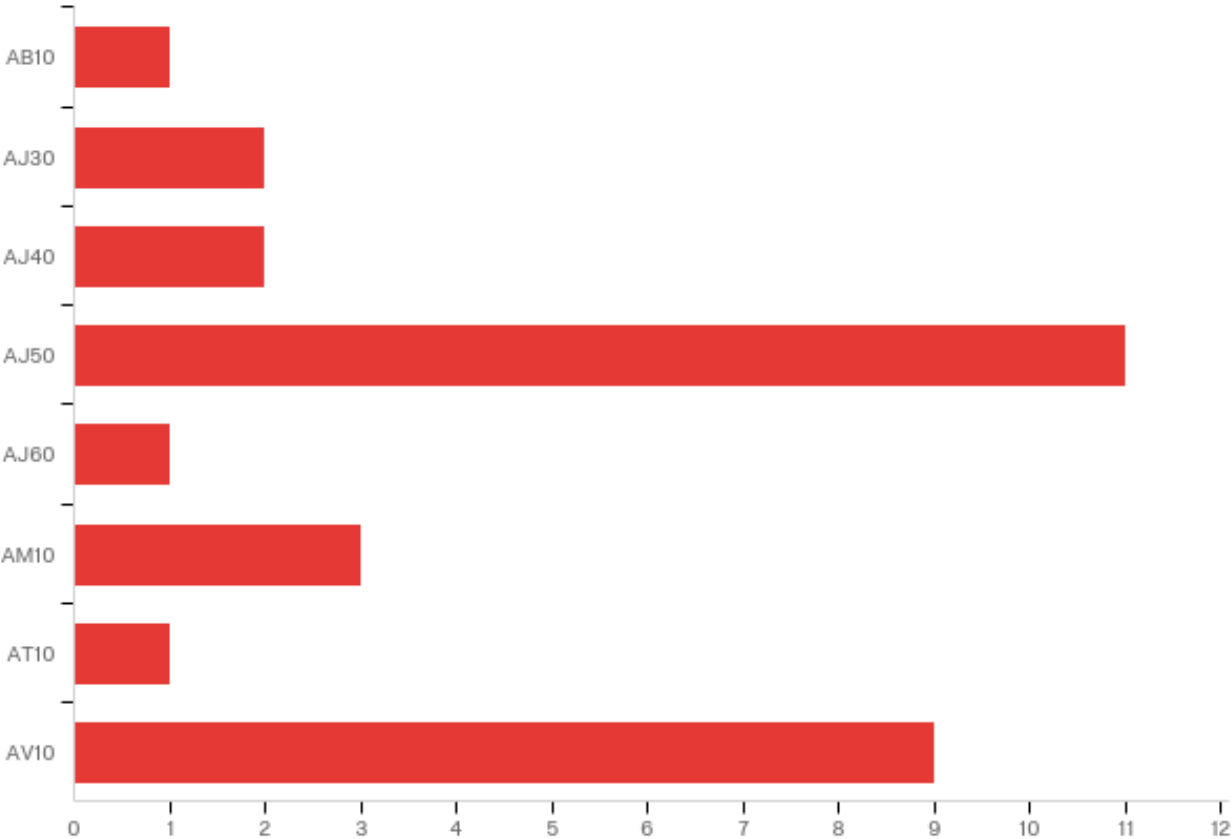

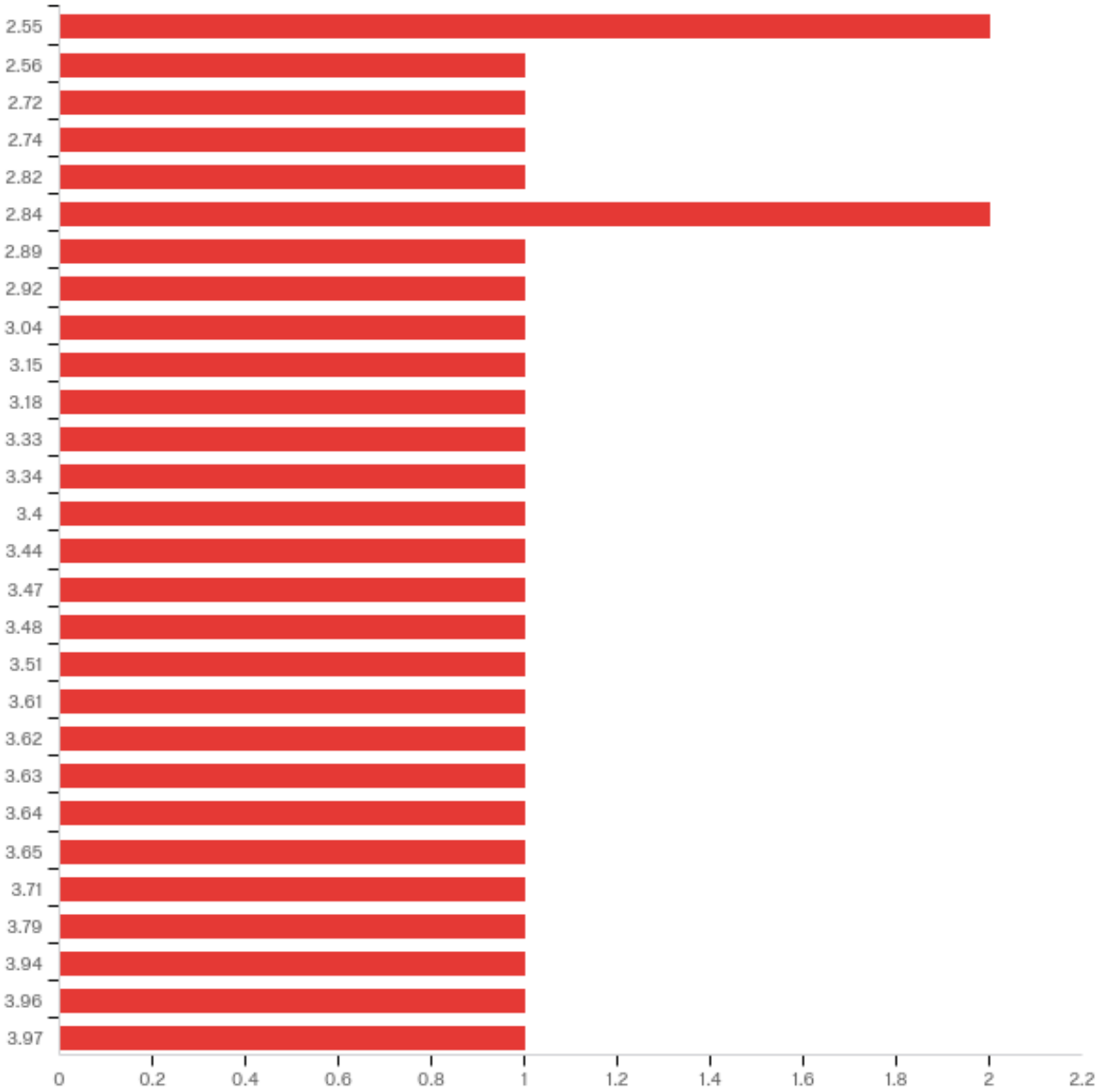
