

#### Q1 - After entering the RBA program, did you finish your coursework







# Q4 - If you were dissatisfied with the portfolio and college equivalent credit process, why were you dissatisfied?









#### Q7 - Family Status











Q11 - During the last year of your studies, how many hours a week did you work while attending classes?








