PLAN OF STUDY

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: In addition to Marshall University's requirements for admission, an applicant must have a bachelor's degree with an undergraduate grade point average (UGPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale from a regionally accredited institution to be fully admitted. A student may be admitted provisionally with less than a GPA of 3.0.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS: All degree students follow a program Plan of Study and must maintain a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0. Failure by the student to return the signed Plan of Study within 30 days will automatically indicate acceptance of its terms. **By signing this form, the student agrees that any applicable transfer credit may be accepted by the university and added to the student's permanent MU academic record. Note: Transfer credits may not be more than seven (7) years old at the time the student completes the MA.**
