Open Registration for all Admitted Students begins **November 11th**.

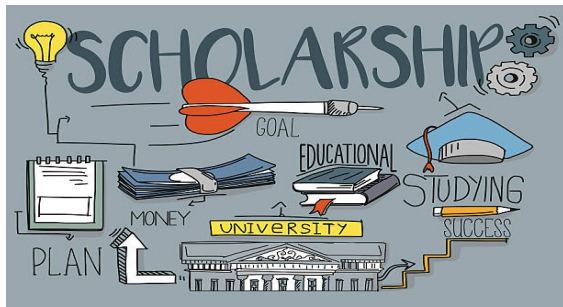
Note: Web Registration (myMU) is available 24 hours daily during designated registration periods. Students on academic probation are not eligible to register online. Registration may occur in person at the Registrar's Office in Old Main 106A Monday through Friday, 8:00am-5:00pm.

Important: Students with outstanding financial and/or academic holds will be denied registration until such holds have been resolved.

Graduation Tuition Benefit Spring, 2020

Scholarship tuition benefits are awarded based on financial need through the Graduate college.

The Graduate College will start accepting applications for the **Spring 2020** benefit in mid-October. Students must have a FAFSA on file with Financial Aid to qualify.

Application Deadline for May 2020 Graduation

The completed application with your paid receipt for the \$50 diploma fee must be submitted to the Graduate College (Dean's office) by **February 7, 2020** for May graduation.

Log into myMU, choose MILO, click Student & Financial Aid Information, click Student Records, click Apply to Graduate - will give detailed instruction at this point.

Graduation will be in **Big Sandy Superstore Arena** on **May 2, 2020**. The Graduate Ceremony times will be announced at a later date.
