

## PLAN OF STUDY

The MSN-PMHNP program can be completed in three academic years of part time study, or over a period not to exceed 7 calendar years from date of first class enrollment. The student must complete the first 25 credit hours of study at Marshall University; then transfer to Shenandoah University to complete the remaining 23 credit hours of specialty psychiatric mental health courses.
