

KNOW YOUR **TITLE IX**

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO FEEL SAFE AND ACCEPTED HERE!

Title IX is a federal law that prohibits the following:



SEXUAL HARASSMENT

Sexual harassment is unwelcome sexual conduct that prohibits a student's access to their education or school-related extracurricular activities.



DATING VIOLENCE

Dating violence is violence committed by a person who is or was in a social, emotional, intimate or romantic relationship with another person.

ONLINE SEXUAL HARASSMENT

Online sexual harassment is the sharing of explicit images (sexting), pornography or other explicit content with or without consent, or by using coercion (extortion), threats or intimidation online.



SEXUAL ASSAULT

Sexual assault is: a forcible or non-forcible sex act or unwelcome sexual conduct that occurs: without consent or when under the influence of drugs/alcohol or while unconscious or using physical force or threats.



CYBERBULLYING

Cyberbullying is when online tools, such as social media are used to intentionally harm, embarrass, threaten, intimidate or humiliate

another person. This includes doxxing, outing, trolling, flaming, extorting, etc.



DISCRIMINATION

Discrimination is harassment or bullying based on gender, sexual orientation, race, class, size, ability, nationality, or other identities.

Discrimination creates a hostile environment at school and interferes with a student's right to access their education.
