Students completing the program may be employed by regional and national airport facilities, airlines, commercial courier services, private aircraft operations, aircraft manufacturers, and similar organizations. With two regional airports servicing the immediate area: Yeager Airport in Charleston, WV, and Tri-State Airport in Huntington, WV, the major will offer experiential learning opportunities
