- Students are required to know and track their degree requirements for graduation or for entrance to a professional school.

- To practice registered professional nursing in West Virginia an individual must be licensed by the West Virginia Board of Examiners for Registered Professional Nurses. Students who successfully complete the Pre-Licensure Bachelor of Science in Nursing program meet the education requirements to apply to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN).
- Starting in the sophomore year of the Pre-Licensure B.S.N. program students must obtain and maintain a current CPR card (Adult, Infant and Child), and


















































- TB test. Failure to have a current CPR card and TB test on file in the nursing office will result in the student being declared ineligible to begin clinical.
- In the sophomore year of the Pre-Licensure B.S.N. program students must successfully pass a background check and drug screen. Contact the School of Nursing at 304-696-6751 for more information.
- Completion of the B.S.N. program requires the completion of 121 semester hours of credits. Credits and grades from developmental courses are not counted.

# PRE-LICENSURE BSN NURSING

The B.S.N. program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing, Inc. The four-year baccalaureate program in nursing prepares professional nurse generalists to work with individuals, families, groups, and communities in a variety of health care settings. The program is available to qualified high school graduates, college students and college graduates. Graduates of the program meet the education requirement to apply to take the National Registered Nurse Licensing Exam (NCLEX-RN).
